I.1 Before starting :

Start the task from your Terminal: `/usr/bin/CCChangePinTool` which is in the Applications:



I.2 Change Pin

The following Window will appaer:



Enter the Initial Pin, if you are doing the activation of your certificate, if not, so enter your current Pin Code which one you want to change.(see red Arrow in the Figure 2).

Enter the new Pin Code in the Field “New Pin Code”, (see blue Arrow in the Figure 2), please confirm your new Pin Code (see green Arrow in the Figure 2).

Validate your change by clicking on “Apply” (see orange Arrow in the Figure 2).

ATTENTION:

The new PIN must only contain numbers, with a minimum of 6 characters and a maximum of 8 characters.



I.3 Error Messages before blocking the product

If you type in the wrong PIN Code, the Gemalto Middleware will show you the following messages:



You have 3 tries before blocking the certificate. (see figure 6)



I.4 Unblock the PIN Code

To unblock the Smartcard/ Signing Stick, please open, the Change PinTool `:/usr/bin/CCChangePinTool` in your Terminal. (Figure 7)



Once the windows is loaded, select “Unblock Pin”, (see red Arrow in the Figure 8).

Enter the PUK Code from your LuxTrust Codes Letter (Admin Pin), in the Field: Admin PIN Code,(see red Arrow in the Figure 8).

Enter a new PIN Code, (see blue Arrow, in the Figure 8) and repeat it in the Field, “Confirm User PIN”, (see green Arrow in the Figure 8).

Validate your action by clicking on “Apply” (see orange Arrow in the Figure 8).



The news PIN must only contain numbers, with a minimum of 6 charakters and a maximum 8 charakters.


